

Downtown Businesses Organize Widows Weekend Event

Join us for Widows Weekend on Watson Saturday Nov 21st from 10-5p in historical downtown Ripon Wisconsin. We will be celebrating the beginning of the holiday season with a much needed (but abundantly cautious) shopping event.

Participants who register for the event will receive a collectible canvas swag bag and MAP of participating businesses. Your swag bag entitles you to the special promotions for the day and free swag bag items as you shop from 10+ businesses along Watson Street!



Details for the day of:

Participants will begin their day in an assigned business based upon the number of people in their party. This will help the flow of the crowd for social distancing purposes. Participants will receive an email with your assigned location to pick up swag bags the day before the event. So be on the look out for it.

Saturday November 21st between 10-11am you will pick up your swag bags from the designated business and kick off your shopping journey. Participants will enjoy special promotions along Watson Street from local dining, boutiques, and participating businesses.

Due to the coronavirus a few extra precautions will be taken for the event. Social distancing will be practiced, and enforced by each shop, based on how many shoppers can be in any space at once. All shoppers/participants are asked to please wear a mask. (*This is under advisement of the current state face mask mandate. Shoppers who cannot wear a mask or face shield may be restricted from entry to some shops.) Select businesses will provide disposable face masks but please come prepared with one. All businesses will ensure their shops are cleaned and sanitized for the safety of their guest. As well as have hand sanitizer on hand for participants.

Downtown Snow Removal Update

Ripon Main Street, Inc. is once again offering the snow removal program to downtown business owners. This service will be in effect starting November 15, 2020 and continue through April 15, 2021.

Snow will be removed from your sidewalk any time there is an accumulation of **2 inches OR more in a single snow fall**. Typically, there are approximately 18 snow removal days each season. This service will be in effect seven days a week, including holidays. Every effort will be made to remove the snow before the start of the business day, completing the process before 8:00 am. **Participating business and property owners are still responsible for maintaining their sidewalks on all dates when accumulations are less than 2 inches.**



City Code requires that your sidewalk be cleared by 10:00 a.m. **All sidewalks must be maintained, kept clear of snow and ice, seven days a week. Offenders will be fined!** Sidewalks which are not maintained are subject to a \$35 fine plus \$25 per hour labor charge to cover the cost of having a public works employee clean the sidewalk.

In order to make this program effective, all businesses are encouraged to participate. Main Street's goal is simply to make the program break even.

Remember, clean sidewalks make it easier for customers to get to your business, decreases your liability risk, and makes for a safer downtown. Utilizing this service is also less expensive than paying your employees to clear sidewalks especially when considering possible workman's compensation claims.
